Participants may set up beginning at 7 am at the west end of Cranes Roost near the fountain.

Team meeting will be at 9:45 to review procedures.

The public will begin tasting at 11 am. Judging will be at 11.

Samples for judging will be collected at 10:45. You will be provided cups for judging samples.

Rotary will also provide tasting cups and spoons.

Public will be issued bracelets. Please serve only to those wearing bracelets.

You may cook the chili you choose. There are no restrictions as to type.

Please provide at least 4 gallons of chili.

Cookers may bring pre-cooked chili or cook on site.

Limited electric is available. Please bring extension cords.

Fire extinguishers are required.

Awards will be announced at 1 p. m.

First, second and third places will be awarded by judges as well as a tasters' choice voted by the public.

You may disassemble and depart at 1 pm.
