### Chili Cook-off

Bring your tents, tables and chairs as well as cooking and preparation supplies.

Participants may set up beginning at 7 a.m. at the west end of Cranes Roost near the fountain.

Vehicles will need to be parked off-site.

Team meeting will be at 10:30 to review procedures.

The public will begin tasting at 11 a.m. Judging will be at 11:30.

Samples for judging will be collected at 11:15. You will be provided cups for judging samples.

Rotary will also provide tasting cups and spoons.

Public will be issued bracelets. Please serve only those wearing bracelets.

Please provide at least 4 gallons of chili.

Bring bottled water if needed.

You may cook the chili you choose. There are no restrictions as to type.

Cookers may bring pre-cooked chili or cook on site.

Limited electric is available. Please bring extension cords.

Fire extinguishers are required.

The judges will determine first, second and third places and a tasters' choice winner will be determined by the public. Tasters' choice is determined by money contributions made during the event at the cooker's tent. The tasters' choice contributions are retained by Rotary as further fund-raising proceeds. Results of the judges tasting and tasters' choice voting will be announced at 1:00 p.m.

You may disassemble and depart at 1:00 p.m.
